A Psalm of David.

he Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

2 The Lord shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies!

- 3 With You is dominion in the day of Your power, in the splendor of Your saints; From the womb, before the morning star have I begotten You.
- 4 The Lord has sworn and will not repent, "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."
- 5 The Lord at Your right hand shall dash in pieces kings in the day of His wrath
- 6 He shall judge among the nations, He shall fill the places with dead bodies, He shall crush the heads of many countries on the earth.

- 5 What ails you, O sea, that you fled? O Jordan, that you turned back?
- 6 You mountains, that you skipped like rams? And you, O little hills, like lambs?

- 7 Tremble, O earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob,
- 8 Who turned the rock into a pool of water, The flint into a fountain of waters.

- 2 Why should the nations say, "So where is their God?"

- 6 They have ears, but they hear not; Noses they have, but they smell not;
- 7 They have hands, but they handle not; Feet they have, but they walk not; Nor do they speak through their throat.
- 8 They that make them are like them; So is everyone that trusts in them.
- 9 O Israel trust in the Lord; He is their help and defender.
- 10 The house of Aaron trusts in the Lord; He is their help and their shield.
- 11 You that fear the Lord, trust in the Lord; For He is our help and defender.
- 12 The Lord has been mindful of us and blessed us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron.
- 13 He will bless those who fear the Lord, both small and great.
- 14 The Lord shall increase you more and more, You and your children.
- 15 May you be blessed by the Lord, Who made heaven and earth.
- 16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's; But the earth He has given to the children of men.
- 17 The dead do not praise the Lord; Nor any of those who go down into silence;
- 18 But we will bless the Lord, from this time forth and forevermore.

- 5 Gracious is the Lord and righteous; Yes, our God is merciful. 6 The Lord preserves the simple; I was brought low and He helped me.
- 7 Return to Your rest, O my soul, for the Lord has been bountiful to You. 8 For He has delivered my soul from death, my eyes from tears, and my feet from falling.
- 9 I will walk before the Lord in the land of the living.

- 6 The Lord is on my side; I shall not fear: what can man do to me.
- 7 The Lord is my helper; And I shall see my desire on those who hate me.
- 8 It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in man.
- 9 It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in princes.
- 10 All nations surrounded me, but in the name of the Lord I will destroy them.
- 11 Yes, they encompassed me, but in the name of the Lord I will destroy them.
- 12 They surrounded me like bees; They are quenched like a fire of thorns; for in the name of the Lord I will destroy them.
- 13 You pushed me violently, that I might fall, but the Lord helped me.
- 14 The Lord is my strength and song, and He has become my salvation.
- 15 The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacle of the righteous; The right hand of the Lord does valiantly.
- 16 The right hand of the Lord is exalted; The right hand of the Lord does valiantly.
- 17 I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.
- 18 The Lord has chastened me severely, but He has not given me over to death.
- 19 Open to me the gates of righteousness; I will go through them, and I will praise the Lord.

- 20 This is the gate of the Lord, through which the righteous shall enter.
- 21 I will praise You, for You have heard me, and have become my salvation.
- 22 The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone.
- 23 This was the Lord's doing; And it is marvelous in our eyes.
- 24 This is the day which the Lord has made; Let us rejoice and be glad in it.
- 25 O Lord, save us; O Lord, send us prosperity!
- 26 Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! We have blessed You from the house of the Lord.
- 27 God is the Lord, and has revealed Himself to us; Celebrate the feast with branches! Bind the sacrifice to the horns of the altar.
- 28 You are my God, and I will praise You; You are my God, and I will exalt You.
- 29 Oh! Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever.

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.

Come, let us worship God our King. Come, let us worship and fall down before Christ, our King. Come, let us worship and fall down before Christ Himself, our King and our God.

And these troparia, Tone 1:

Another world awaits you, O soul, and the Judge intends to reveal the hidden and wicked things concerning you. Do not be taken up with the here and now, but look ahead and cry out to the Judge: O God, cleanse me and save me.

Covered with the countless wounds of my transgressions, O Christ Savior, I the sinner entreat Your tender mercy: O Physician of the sick, visit, heal, and save me.

Why are you living in negligence and laziness, O my soul? Why are you not concerned with the evil you have done in your life? Hasten to make amendments before the Lord shuts the door to you. Run to the Birthgiver of God, fall down and cry: O hope of the hopeless, I have greatly sinned against you; save me, O all-pure sovereign Lady.

Lord, have mercy (40x).

Holy Lord Who dwells in the highest, Who looks down with Your all-seeing eye upon the whole creation, we bow the neck of body and soul to You and beseech You, O Holy of Holies: stretch forth Your unseen hand from Your holy dwelling place and bless us all and forgive all our sins, whether voluntary or involuntary, of word or of deed. Give us tender compunction, O Lord; give us spiritual tears from deep within for the cleansing of our many sins. Grant Your great mercy to Your world and to us, also, Your unworthy servants. For blessed and highly glorified is Your name, of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit; Both now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.
